



LNV TRAINS LOCAL BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB STAFF



CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS - LNV offered first response training to the staff at the Boys and Girls Club of Corpus Christi and Robstown at no cost to them.

"I love how hands-on this training is," said Veronica Blanco, program director. "I definitely feel more confident about my ability to care for the kids in the event of an accident."

The training is expected to create a safer environment for the 225+ local children participating in the organization's summer program in Corpus Christi and Robstown. During the first aid training, the staff learned how to respond to common emergencies (e.g., burns, cuts, head, neck and back injuries, etc.). In the CPR/AED training, the staff was taught ways to respond to cardiac and breathing emergencies. Also included in the training were precautions to help prevent the spread of bloodborne pathogens. Roy Montemayor, LNV's training consultant, conducted the six hour training May 26.
